- Strong work ethic and personal resilience and the capacity to develop these as strengths in others.
- Demonstrated leadership to develop coaching practices and the capabilities of others in the coaching team.

Desirable Requirements

- Possess minimum Level 1 NCAS Accreditation (preferably Level 2) or equivalent experience at elite level basketball
- Must have a current "Working with Vulnerable People" registration card or attain one within the first month after appointment to this position
